The Center for the Performing Arts first opened the doors on the Palladium in January, 2011 after an extensive design and construction process. The Center's three performance venues offer a home for local theatre, dance and music organizations as well as world-class visiting artists in all disciplines.

The Palladium is a domed European style concert hall with a four-fronted, symmetrical design seating 1600 patrons.

The Tarkington is a 500-seat proscenium theater best suited to theatre, musicals, dance and lectures.

The Studio Theater is a flexible theatrical space that houses several local resident companies and hosts national touring performers. The Studio has four stage/seating configurations: cabaret, proscenium, in the round, and thrust.

Kyle Lemoi, The Center's Director of Production will lead participants in an extensive tour of the three performing spaces and the support spaces that are required to present a wide variety of events in three very different venues.
